## Webinar with Dr. Maureen W. Lovett

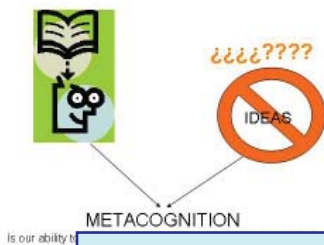
